Improved Soil Health and Structure:

Long-term research at the University of Guelph's Ridgetown campus demonstrates that including winter wheat in your crop rotation can yield an additional 10 bushels per acre of corn and 5 bushels per acre of soybeans. With current crop prices, this translates to an extra profit of \$150-180 per acre directly attributable to adding wheat to your crop rotation.

Hilliard is a robust performer in the C&M Seeds' soft red lineup,

well-suited for farms across the province. Known for its rapid emergence and superior tolerance to all current leaf diseases, Hilliard's racehorse characteristics make it ideal for intensive management. This light green variety emerges swiftly, tillers well in the fall, and begins growing early in the spring. Save money through reduced seeding rates.

SOFT RED WINTER WHEAT

Swoop is the latest addition to the C&M Seeds lineup, offering high adaptability across Ontario. This medium-tall variety produces abundant straw and boasts excellent yields and strong disease resistance. Swoop is an ideal replacement for growers who favoured CM 614. Swoop offers tall growth with average standability, and its performance improves further east, making it particularly well-suited for Quebec and Eastern Ontario.

SERIOUS KNOWLEDGE Swoop is turning into an area 3 performer. With all of our regional testing, this new variety improves for yield the further east you move. Just remember that tall varieties sometimes need a PGR. Place Swoop in Area 2 or Area 3 or on clay. It is a great CM614 replacement.
